

Metro Richmond Science Fair Students Advance



While Metro Richmond Science Fair Grand Prize Winners Robert Brik (Mills E. Godwin High School) and Erin Kim (The Mathematics & Science High School at Clover Hill), automatically advanced to the 2008 Intel International Science & Engineering Fair in Atlanta, Georgia in mid-May, other winners from the Metro Richmond Science Fair had one more chance to grab the ring at the Virginia State Science and Engineering Fair in early April.

Held this year at George Mason University, our Central Virginia students did very well. They received 3 firsts, 2 seconds, 1 third, 1 honorable mention and 8 special awards. But one student, Suraj Mishra from Mills E. Godwin High School did grab the ring! He was one of two students named Best of Fair at VSSEF 2008. Mishra and Sappho Gilbert from northern Virginia's Thomas Jefferson High School for Science and Technology now advance to the 2008 Intel International Science & Engineering Fair in Atlanta.
